A meet and greet with artist Sue Coleman including signing event, new watercolor releases, new giclee prints and an “artist chat” session!

Sue Coleman will visit Knight Visions Studio Gallery Bothell, WA this Friday March 13th from 5-9 P.M. and Saturday March 14th from 10-2 P.M. to introduce her new watercolor original releases and giclee prints. Included will be a very special “artist chat” on Friday afternoon before the studio evening event for an art and cultural exchange including art techniques and what is happening within the Canadian art scene with the winter Vancouver Olympics approaching this coming winter of 2010. This is an exciting event for art patrons of Sue Coleman to have their art purchases autographed, as it has been over ten years since her last visit.

Coleman gained international recognition with her interpretive Northwest Coastal indigenous Nations’ images combining both the native symbolic and realistic wildlife images in one scene. Extensive research is often employed for each image and Coleman culminated eight years of research in the extensive book, “An Artist’s Vision” which displays her native interpretive works intertwining the legends, folklore and history and her love of nature with each piece. Sue Coleman works from her studio in Cowichan Bay on Vancouver Island in British Columbia, Canada and her works are represented in limited edition reproductions and lithographs, giclees, art cards, poster, collector plates, books and of course original watercolors.

Exhibitions include Epcot Center in Walt Disney World (1995-1996), Ducks Unlimited winner of “Silver Teal Award” (1994), Guest artist for the government of British Columbia Embassy Show Tokyo, Japan (1991) and an ongoing artist in residence for “World Explorer Cruise Lines” Alaskan cruises for the past ten years.
